

Policies for Use of Berkeley County South Carolina Amateur Radio Emergency Service (ARES) Repeaters

Berkeley ARES maintains two VHF repeaters and one, portable UHF repeater.

- 146.610- Tone 123.0 CTCSS - located at the County Landfill site on US52
- 147.150+ Tone 91.5 CTCSS - located at the Berkeley EOC in Moncks Corner
- 440.750+ or 440.800+ (selectable) No Tone - portable

Use of the 146.610 repeater is restricted to Berkeley ARES members and invited guests only.

The 147.150 repeater is open to all licensed amateurs. However, use of the 147.150 repeater may be restricted at any time when being used for exercises or during an actual incident.

Permission to use the portable UHF repeater will be granted on an as-needed basis.

Any repeater may be used by anyone, at any time, for a real-life emergency.

All users of the repeaters must be mindful that others can listen in to their conversations, including children. Keep all discourse civil and do not use coarse, vulgar or obscene language at any time. All users should identify with their call at the beginning of a conversation and at the intervals prescribed by FCC regulations.
